Dear Parents and Carers,

Uniforms

We do have uniforms in stock. If you have ordered items or would like more of anything, please come in and speak to the School Office. Uniforms are available for payment and collection on THURSDAYS.

Travel Shelter

We are delighted with our new Travel Shelter that was installed in the main playground during the summer holidays. This will be of real benefit during wet playtimes and on rainy days when parents are welcome to use the shelter at the start or end of the school day. May I remind you that there is to be no smoking or dogs allowed within school grounds.

School Meals

School dinners cost £1.70 a day or £8.50 a week. Money should be given to your child's Teaching Assistant in a named envelope each Monday morning. As we only have a small number of children taking meals at the moment, the menu choices have been reduced. These will be back to normal once all our children are in school at lunchtime.

If you believe you qualify for free school meals, please ask for an application form at the School

Office. All enquiries are dealt with confidentially and school benefits financially if you register, even if you then decide to provide sandwiches for your child.

Voluntary Contributions

As with previous years we will start collecting voluntary contributions next Monday. This money helps support additional purchases throughout the year and enhances our children's learning. Please give your £1 to your child's Teaching Assistant each Monday morning.

Pushchairs

Please do not bring pushchairs in to the building as they are a health and safety hazard. At the start/end of the day, parents are welcome to leave buggies in the foyer or under the shelters in the main playground.



Contact details and Medication

Please make sure your contact details are updated at the school office. Also, if your child has an inhaler or other medication, please make sure it is still in date. This will help us in the event of any emergency.

Unwanted Clothing

If your child has grown out of their trousers, socks or pants, we would really appreciate them in school. Please send any items in to the school office and we will give them out to classes. This will really help us in the event of any "accidents" in school or nursery. Thank you!
