We are looking for staff to run it who have NVQ 3 level. If you are interested or know anyone who would be, please ask them to pop in for a job description from Wednesday 13th December.

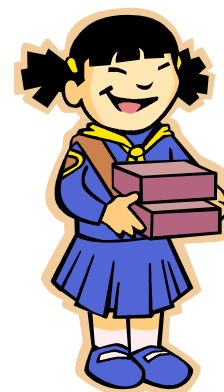
If this is successful we will look to making it permanent from January 2008.

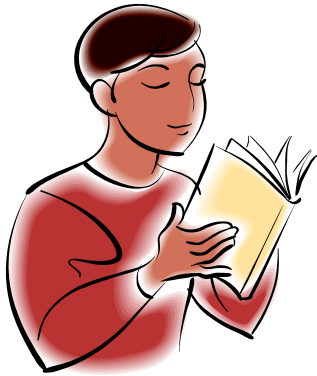
