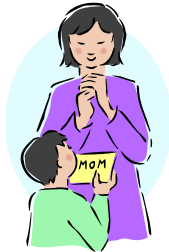

Mothering Service

This is on Thursday 28th. Nursery and Reception parents have been invited to their service at 9:10 in the school hall.

Parking
