Unexplained Absences

We have reviewed our absence records for the first part of this term. We appreciate that there has been a lot of illness and most parents have kept us informed if their child is ill.



However, there are a small number of children with “unexplained absences” on their record. If your child is one of these, we have attached a copy of their Registration Certificate for your reference, highlighting the days in question.

Please can you return this form to the School Office with the reason for your child’s absence WRITTEN ON THE REVERSE by Monday 30th November. Otherwise any unexplained marks will have to be recorded as “unauthorised”. This is not good for your child’s record or our school, so your co-operation with this is appreciated.

Dinner money

Unfortunately, we are having problems with some parents ordering dinners for their child and then not being forthcoming with the payment. Please remember dinner money should be paid ON THE DAY or in advance please.

School cannot afford to provide meals without payment as we have to pay for them every week. **Some problems arise because parents are entitled to free school meals but have not yet applied;** we have been given strict instruction not to provide meals in these circumstances as the payment can not be backdated. It is therefore really important that you make the application. It can be done by telephone if you prefer, please ask in the office if you need any help with this.

Voluntary contributions

Voluntary contributions (£1 a week) should be paid to your child’s Teaching Assistant each Monday (in an envelope if in Years 1 or 2). Wednesdays in Nursery.

If you still owe pantomime or trip money, please send this to the School Office as soon as possible. **Exact money is always preferred as we often struggle to find change.** Thank you.
